Additional Summer Reading Program Information

- Students may check out 2 books and take AR tests during the summer hours.
- The deadline for **ALL** required summer AR tests will be Friday, August 18th.
- The student's **USER NAME** is five letters – the first letter of their first name followed by the first four letters of their last name. Their **PASSWORD** is three letters – their initials: first, middle, and last.
- Students should bring the book they are using or at least write down the name and author of their book. They will need this information to take the test.
- The library is a **QUIET ZONE** during summer testing. Children must be supervised. Students are not to be dropped off and left in the school building or library unsupervised. All conversations should take place outside the library. Remember our students need to concentrate as they test. Please be courteous.

HRA Summer Reading Requirements 2017

Students going into THIRD grade

Read and take AR quizzes on TWO AR books of their choice that are 2.0 grade level or higher.

Students going into FOURTH grade

Please see attached sheet.

Students going into FIFTH grade

Students must read and take an AR quiz on ONE Newberry Award Winner or Newberry Honor Book. The book must be 4.0 or higher. Please work together to choose a book that interests your child. Read the summaries carefully to ensure the subject matter is appropriate and interesting for your child. As always, use the AR finder to help you with the selection as well.
